### ISRAEL AT WAR

We have been supporting and strengthening Israel and the Jewish People around the world.

- **Shuk to the Core Israeli Vendor Fairs** (in collaboration with Tal Tours and Mental Health First Aid Israel): 10 Days. 10 Fairs. 32 Vendors. Over \$600,000 in revenue.
- **On the Ground in Israel:** Coordinating volunteer efforts to support victims and families, provide hot meals to soldiers, help farms that are suffering from severe labor shortages and other vital projects.
- **Areyvut Alumni Projects:** Areyvut alumni initiated a Free the Hostages lawn-sign campaign, played a key role in organizing the student-led Global Day of Loving Kindness (October 22nd) and have been highly active across their campuses, communities and social media.
- **Chayalim:** Directly provided clothing and equipment to 2,250 soldiers.
- **Hostages:** Free the Hostages lawn signs and supporting organizations and families.
- **Advocacy:** On social media, at rallies and through direct e-mail and telephone outreach to government officials and others, we are advocating for Israel and educating the non-Jewish community on the realities of the global threat posed by terrorists and their supporters.
